Temporary Speaker (Hon. Muga): Leader of Majority, the floor is yours.

Deputy Majority Leader (Hon. Pamela): Thank you Madam Speaker, I stand to move a motion on the adjournment of the Progress Report on Ad Hoc Committee investigating the conduct of the members of the Kisumu County Public Service Board.

Madam Speaker, the matter before us is in the court and the law is very clear that issues that are pending before any court of law are not subject of discussion. Temporary Speaker (Hon. Muga): Thank you Hon. Okiri for giving that advice. I believe that the Majority Leader will come up with the report after the court ruling and bring it back to the House.

Deputy Majority Leader (Hon. Pamela): Thank you Madam Speaker, I am only withdrawing this report because the matter is in court. This report will still be brought back to this House after 1 week. We cannot suspend forever. So by next week on Thursday we will bring another progress report.

Temporary Speaker (Hon. Muga): Thank you Majority Leader, I think the better language to use there is to say that we suspend this matter till the time the report will be ready to be brought before the House.

Deputy Majority Leader (Hon. Pamela): Madam Speaker, I think we are going to suspend it until next week on Thursday.

Temporary Speaker (Hon. Muga): Thank you Majority Leader. Honorable Members, since the motion has been suspended for some time, I want to ask the Honorable Members if anyone has something to say as we look forward to what is coming next. Hon. Prisca please.

Hon. Prisca: I believe that, if the Leader of Majority has already suspended this motion then you should put a question then the session ends.
