MOTION ON ADJOURNMENT FOR MATTERS OF COUNTY IMPORTANCE

Mr. Speaker and Hon. Members

THAT AWARE THAT, the Ministry of Interior and National Administration being responsible for maintaining internal security, overseeing national registration services, managing immigration policies, and coordinating National Government functions.

FURTHER AWARE THAT, in execution of its mandate, the Ministry has initiated a program of citizen engagement through Town Hall Meetings across all forty-seven (47) counties with the objective of enhancing public participation, assessing the security situation on the ground, and building synergies with devolved institutions.

COGNIZANT THAT, the Ministry has scheduled a Town Hall Meeting in Kisumu County on Thursday 18th and Friday, 11th September, 2025, to be presided over by the Cabinet Secretary for Interior and National Administration, Hon. Kipchumba Murkomen, EGH. During the said meeting, the Cabinet Secretary will meet with county leadership, Members of Parliament, Members of the County Assembly, and security agencies to deliberate on security matters as well as the Government's Bottom-Up Economic Transformational Agenda (BETA).

NOTING THAT, the Cabinet Secretary has formally extended an invitation to the Governor, Members of Parliament, and Members of the County Assembly to participate in this engagement forum, which is of urgent County importance given the prevailing security concerns in the region.

RECALLING THAT, pursuant to Standing Order 28 (Hours of Meeting), the Assembly sits on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, and pursuant to Standing Order 30 (Adjournment of the County Assembly), a Member may move a motion for adjournment at any time for stated reasons. Further, pursuant to Standing Order 36 (Motions which may be moved without Notice), a motion for the adjournment of the County Assembly may be moved without notice.

NOW THEREFORE, I pray that this Honourable House, pursuant to Standing Orders 25 (Regular Sessions of the County Assembly), 28 (Hours of Meeting), 30 (Adjournment of the County Assembly) and 36 (Motions without Notice), resolves to adjourn its plenary sittings to Tuesday, 23rd September, 2025, in

order to allow Honourable Members to participate fully in the scheduled Town Hall Meeting convened by the Ministry of Interior and National Administration.
