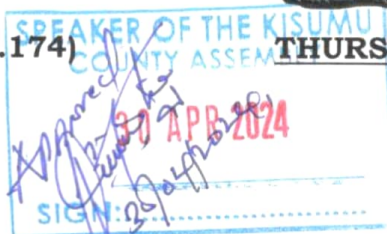

LIMITATION OF DEBATES

The House resolved on Wednesday, 21st February, 2024 as follows-

Limitation of Debate on Bills sponsored by Parties or Committees

- I. **THAT**, pursuant to the provisions of Orders No. 95(1) of the Standing Orders, this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on Bills sponsored by a Committee, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party be limited as follows: - A maximum of thirty five (35) minutes for the Mover, in moving and fifteen minutes (15) in replying, a maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Chairperson of the relevant Committee (if the Bill is not sponsored by the relevant Committee), and a maximum of five (5) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) Minutes (if the Bill is not sponsored by him); and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
