

## **LIMITATION OF DEBATES**

**The House resolved on Tuesday, 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2025 as follows-**

### Limitation of Debate on Reports

**I. THAT,** pursuant to the provisions of Orders No. 95(1) of the Standing Orders, this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on a Report of a Committee, a Sessional Paper or any other Report submitted to the Assembly, be limited as follows: - A maximum of three (3) hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover in moving and ten (10) minutes in replying, and a maximum of five (5) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes; and that priority be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party in that Order.

### Limitation of Debate on Motions

**II. THAT,** pursuant to the provisions of Orders No. 95(1) of the Standing Orders, this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on any Motion, including a Special motion be limited in the following manner: -A maximum of two (2) hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and five (5) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
