LIMITATION OF DEBATES

The House resolved on Wednesday, 21st February, 2024 as follows-

Limitation of Debate on Reports

- I. **THAT**, pursuant to the provisions of Orders No. 95(1) of the Standing Orders, this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on a Report of a Committee, a Sessional Paper or any other Report submitted to the Assembly, be limited as follows: - A maximum of three (3) hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover in moving and ten (10) minutes in replying, and a maximum of five (5) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes; and that priority be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party in that Order.
