### **LIMITATION OF DEBATES**

**The House resolved on Wednesday, 21<sup>st</sup> February, 2024 as follows-**

#### Limitation of Debate on Adjournment Motions

- I. **THAT**, notwithstanding the provisions of Orders No. 26(3), this House proposes that, the debate on any Motion for the Adjournment of the Assembly to a day other than the next normal Sitting day in accordance with the Calendar of the Assembly, be limited to:- A maximum of three (3) hours with not more than five (5) minutes for each Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority who shall be limited to a maximum of ten (10) minutes; and that priority be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party in that order. Provided that, when the period of Recess proposed by any such Motion does not exceed ten (10) days, the debate shall be limited to a maximum of thirty minutes.
