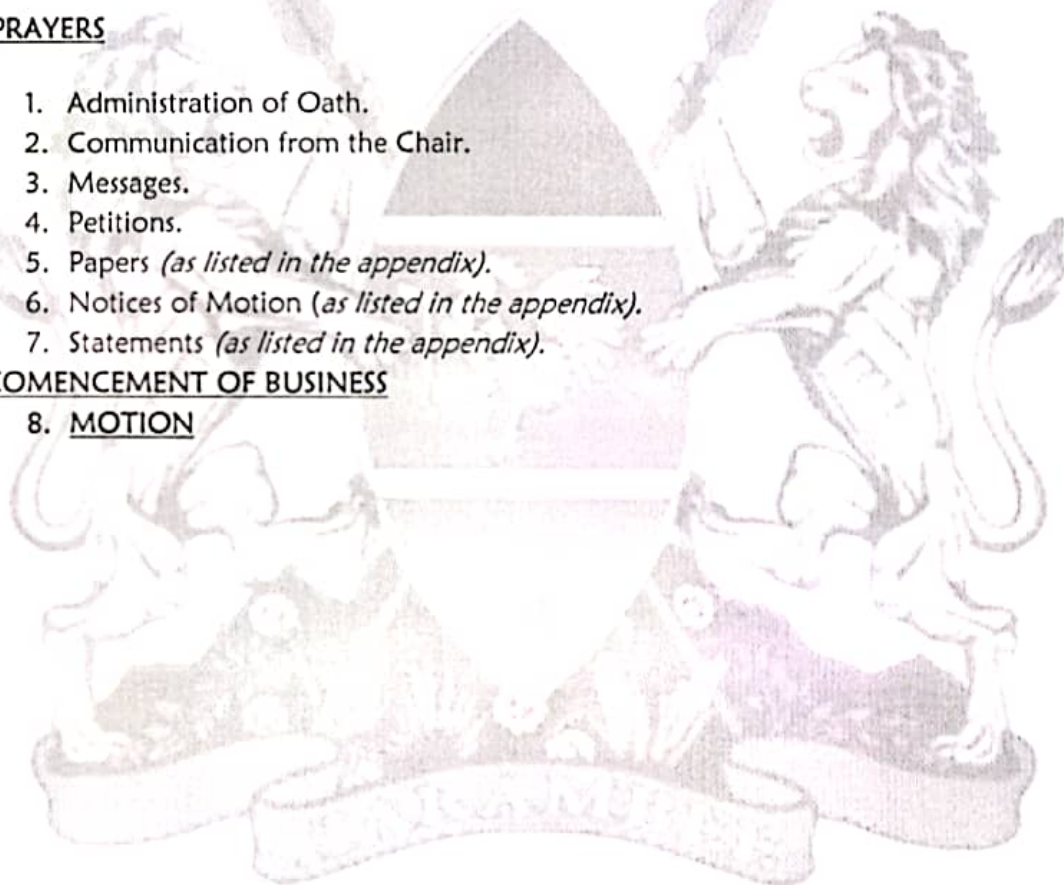

3. STATEMENTS:

- A. Pursuant to Standing Order 41(2,a, b), I rise to seek a Statement from the Chairperson of the Committee on Water, Environment and Natural Resources about the water crisis in Bukna area (Katiega, Kobuya and Aora-Meya) in Kajulu Ward.

Hon. Speaker, the perennial water problem in these areas had occasioned some short term interventions by the County Government that led to provision of water tankers as temporary water collection point at Fourways area that has since come to an end. The Bukna water project that was meant to offer a long-term solution equally stopped working thus disadvantaging a huge number of domestic, institutional and industrial water users in the area putting lives of a huge number of people including women and children at risks. This is despite the fact that Kajulu Ward is home to several water catchment areas including the KIWASCO water reservoir serving large parts of Kisumu City with clean and safe water at the expense of residents of Kajulu.

In the statement, the Chairperson should;

1. Give details why the Bukna water points including Fourways-Kobuya water project, Katiega, and Aora-Meya water projects are not functional and plans for construction, or repair and operationalization in order to provide water to neighboring communities
2. Explain why the water catchment areas in Kajulu including Aora-Meya catchment area cannot be gazetted and protected for sustainable development and water provision

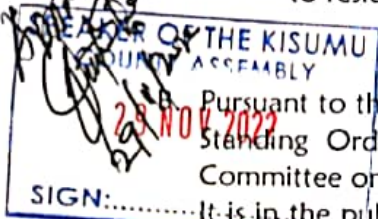
