## **Statements Hour.**

In accordance with **Standing Order No. 41 (2) (b)** during the Statement hour, Hon. George Ogutu raised a Statement, requiring the Chairperson for the Committee on ECDE and Vocational Training; Hon. David Arao to make a reply on the following issues affecting the Department of Education within the County.

- a) Why disbursements for sponsored students for the year 2018/19 have not been made especially in the wards' vocational training institutions like Ubambe in West Nyakach, Masogo in Nyang'oma, Mariwa in North Seme and other TIVET institutions.
- b) Why the disbursements for TIVET students for the year 2019/2020 has been reduced and the cause of the delay.
- c) What measures the department has put in place to mitigate the suffering of the above students bearing in mind that are bound to miss out on their examinations failure to pay their fees.
- d) The whereabouts of the appropriation money for the financial year 2018/2019 and why it was not disbursed while the bursary money for 2019/2020 was disbursed.
- e) Why the money for TIVET for the year 2019/2020 was wired to a different account from TIVET individual account.

## **Speaker's Ruling**

The presiding chair, Hon. Seth Okumu directed the Chairperson; Hon. David Arao to make response on the Statement raised on the floor of the House on a date not later than 4<sup>th</sup> June 2020.

## Statements Hour.

A motion on the Report from the Committee on Ward Development on the Bench marking to the Senate was moved by Hon. George Ogutu; Vice Chairperson for the Committee on Ward Development and was seconded by Hon. Joseph Olale; Chairperson for the Committee.

The Report of the Committee on Ward Development on the Bench marking Mission at the Senate from 17<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> October, 2019 in Nairobi was thus adopted on 26<sup>th</sup> May, 2020 at 1522Hrs.

## Speaker's Ruling

The presiding Chair, ruled that the Office of the Clerk to take up the report and communicate to the executive the recommendations of the report in furtherance of developments at the Ward level.

### **Guidelines Recommended by the Office of the Controller of Budget on the Establishment of Ward Development Fund**

- The relevant department or County entity identifies the need for establishment of the Ward Development Fund.
- The proposal is forwarded to the County Executive Committee Member for Finance as per Section 116 (1) of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012.
- The County Executive Committee Member for Finance presents the proposal on the establishment of the Ward Development Fund to the County Executive Committee for approval.
- Upon approval by the County Executive Committee, the County Executive Committee Member for Finance prepares the County Bill or County Regulation that will establish and operationalise the fund in line with Article 183(2) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010.

The Assembly approved the committee's recommendation that the Kisumu County Ward Development Fund (Amendment) Act, 2016 be forwarded to the County Executive Committee Member for Finance as per Section 116 (1) of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012, to initiate the amendment process so as to be in consistence with the existing laws and in accordance with the guidelines set out by the Controller of Budget.
