The Speaker (Hon. Oraro): Hon. Members, I want to refer to the provisions of County Assembly Standing Order No. 32 (2) and request that the Serjeant-at-Arms rings the quorum bell for five minutes.

The Speaker (Hon. Oraro): I want to request under Standing Order No. 32 (2) that the Serjeant-at-Arms to ring the quorum bell for another five minutes.

The Speaker (Hon. Oraro): The Minority Whip, could you please confirm if we have quorum.

The Minority Whip (Hon. Agengo): Mr. Speaker, we still don't have the required quorum. Thank you.

The Speaker (Hon. Oraro): Thank you. Honourable Members, I want to refer you to Standing Order No. 32 (2) and it stipulates that;

"If there is not a quorum present when the Chair is taken at the time appointed for a meeting of the County Assembly, immediately after the saying of the Prayer, the Speaker shall order the bell

to be rung for five minutes, and if no quorum is present at the expiration of the five minutes, the Speaker may direct that the bell be rung for a further five minutes and if there is still no quorum present, the Speaker shall adjourn the County Assembly forthwith to the next sitting”.
