#### **STATEMENT.**

**The temporary Speaker** (Hon. Inviolata): Yes Hon. Guya.

**Hon. Guya:** Thank you Madam Speaker. I want to make a Personal Statement while citing the provisions of Standing Order No. 42. Hon. Okiri, I hope it is Standing order No. 42?

Madam Speaker, as a representative of South East Nyakach Ward and given that I also come from Nyakach. Nyakach is in mourning given that we lost our first Member of Parliament and the second Senator of this great County who shall be buried this Friday 11<sup>th</sup> March, 2022. I just want to take this opportunity to pass my condolence to his family the late Hon. Cleophas Ondik Chilo, who served as a Senator after Senator D.O Makasembo. Madam Speaker, I sdeek the indulgence of this House and wish that if you could give Members the opportunity who wish to pass their condolence to the family am just requesting you because you have that power and given that the late Senator is also your grandfather.

**Hon. Okiri:** Thank you Madam Speaker, the Honorable, I can now call him the former senator is a well-known personality not only in the politics of this County but also in this nation and I would wish to stand together with the people of Nyakach through their elected representative Hon. Guya to say that we the people of Kisumu convey our condolences to the entire family of Mr. Ondiek Chilo and the people of Nyakach.

Madam Speaker, the fallen hero can be remembered by quite a number of things. We know that Mzee D.O was the first Senator, after a by-election, the fallen hero became the second and we would still view him as the first. He was the only surviving Member of the Legco fraternity in the 1960-1970's. We would then say as members of this community that we have lost a great personality who was very charming.

Madam Speaker, I would want to say that last year when I visited Thurdibuoro we went there to install a chief. He was present and did encourage the people and notably he was talking about establishment of peace Caucuses in the greater County of Kisumu. Madam Speaker, Hon. Ondik Chilo was seriously looking forward for the installation of the President Rt. Hon. Raila Odinga to lead this Nation for the fifth time however, he is not here to witness what we are about to see but we would say that as a people, we are going to be there to at least watch and participate on his behalf. I would wish to include the people of Kisumu in passing our condolences to the fallen hero. Thank you.

It is unfortunate that we are just about to reach where we wanted to go and now he is gone before we reach there. God gives and he takes. We will eulogize him though with heavy hearts. Fare thee well and let the family be united. Thank you.
