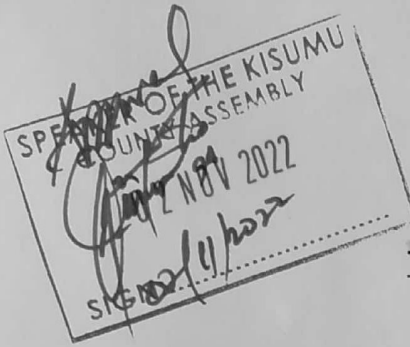

2. STATEMENT.

It is extremely sad and unbelievable that a Sub County Hospital that Chulaimbo is, it has no back up plan in case of power blackout. Last week I was visiting a patient when power went out and close to ten minutes later, the hospital was still engulfed in total darkness. Upon inquiry I was made to understand that a facility of such stature has no backup plan.

I was informed of several instances where power has gone off amidst deliveries and nurses forced to use their mobile phones' flashlights to carry out such important process.

Hon. Speaker, it is in this regard that I seek a statement from the Chairperson Committee on Health, Housing and Sanitation to investigate and report on;

- i. Why there is no power backup plan at the facility.
- ii. What measures the Health Department is doing to ensure that there is either solar or generator to salvage the already soiled reputation of the Hospital.
