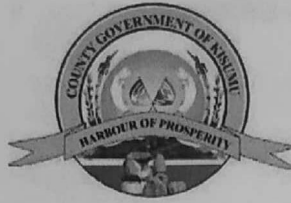

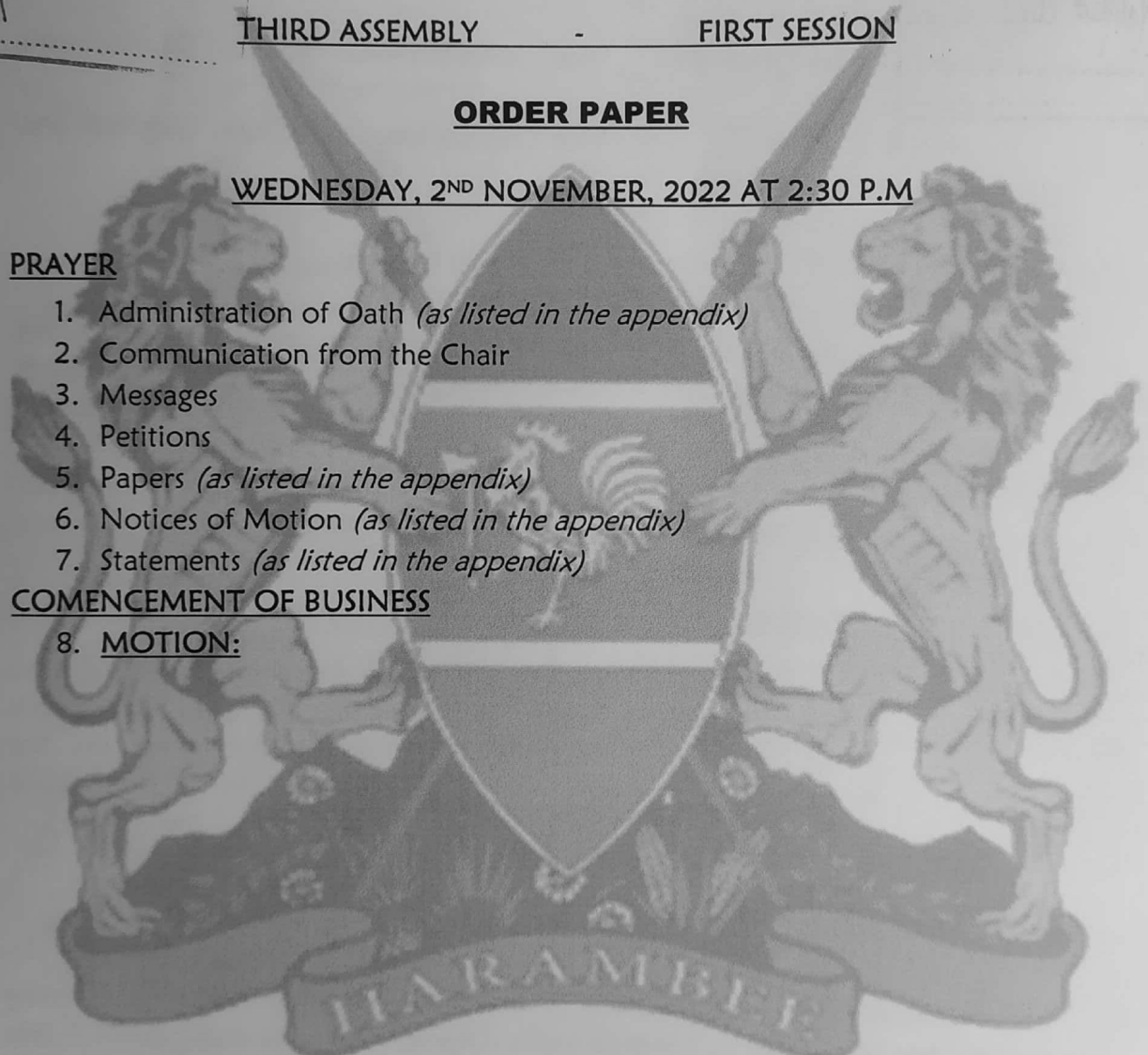

RECOGNIZING that there is a long-standing correlation between light, accidents and crime, and that streetlights and floodlights play big roles among them promoting security in the markets to traders, on the road to road users and enhancing visibility.

In light of the above, it has come to my attention that most streetlights and floodlights within the County are either faulty or not functioning at all. Below are a sample of areas affected in my ward.

Floodlights

- a) Kowino center - Not functioning
- b) Catholic center - On throughout
- c) Kingdom power - Only two are functioning
- d) Dago - Only one eye is functional

Streetlights

- i. Nairobi road (Nyamasaria) to town- Several are not working.
- ii. Ringroad Kachock to Dunga - Several are not working
- iii. Cornerbar to Kajobita - Several are not working
- iv. Western to Okonyowelo - Several are not working

Hon. Speaker, it is against this backdrop that I seek for the Chairperson, Committee on Public Works, Roads and Transport to probe and report to this House on;

- a) All areas apart from the above mentioned that are affected and what the department is doing to ensure that all streetlights and floodlights are fully functional.
- b) That there is a maintenance team in place so that in case of default, members of the public know where to channel their grievances.
