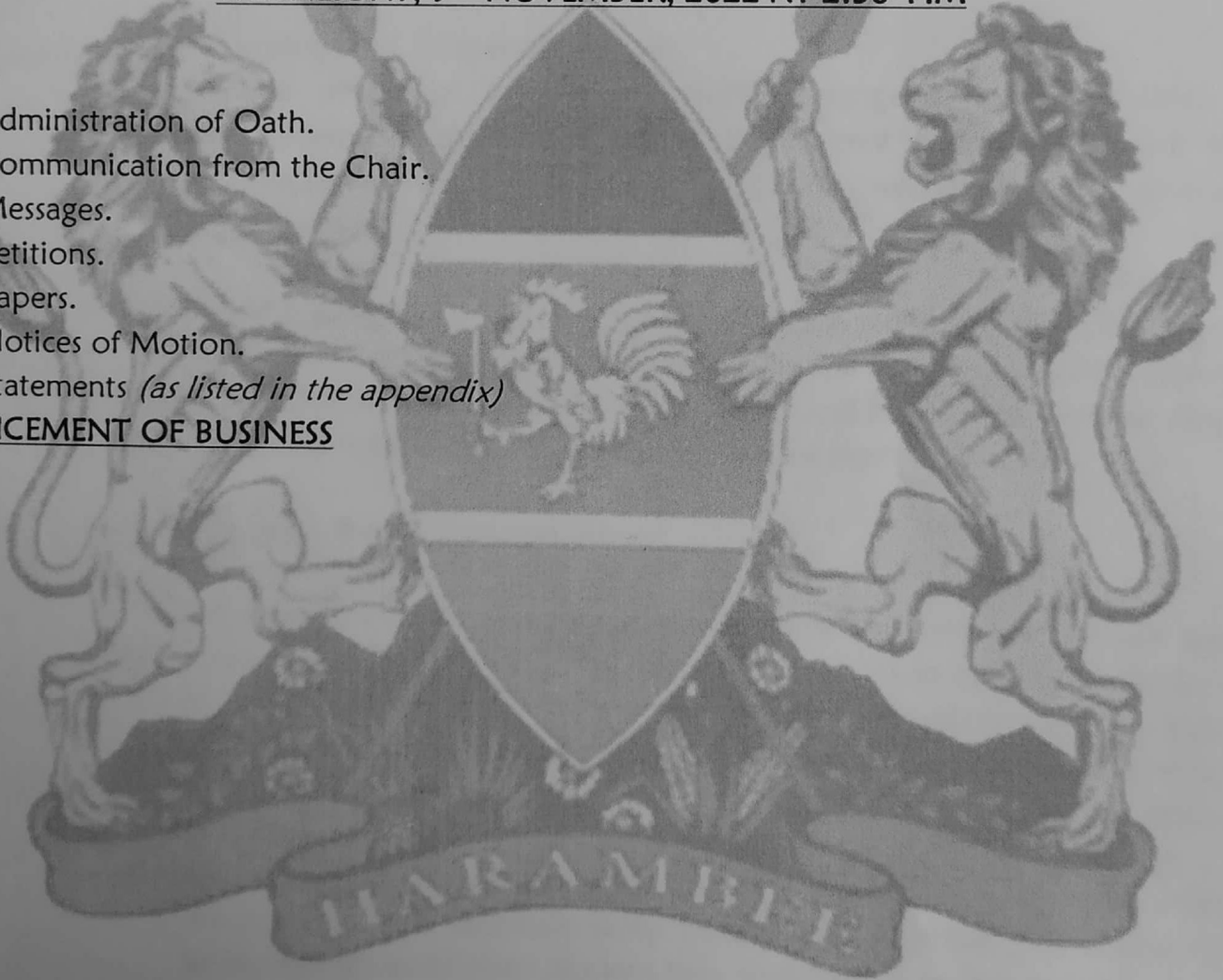

1. STATEMENTS.

(Hon Lumumba Owade MCA, South East Nyakach)

A. Pursuant to Standing Order 41(2,a, b), I rise to seek a Statement from the Chairperson of the Committee on Cooperatives, Finance, Trade and Enterprise Development on the general safety of trade merchandise in Sondu market in South East Nyakach. The market is currently lacking any market-security arrangements thus exposing the trade-wares to increased cases of theft of goods in the market.

In the statement, the Chairperson should;

- i. Provide details of the market-security arrangements and general market management mechanisms that the department has put in place to offer sustainable safety and security services to the merchandise and trade-wares in Sondu market.

B. Pursuant to Standing Order 41(2,a, b), I rise to seek a Statement from the Chairperson of the Committee on Water, Environment and Natural Resources on the perennial lack of cleanliness and unhygienic conditions in Sondu and Nyabondo Markets despite the continued uninterrupted daily collection of revenue from the traders.

In the statement, the Chairperson should;

- i. Provide explanations as to why there have not been officers or personnel employed or engaged by the County Government to offer the requisite market cleaning services and maintenance of general hygiene and environmental cleanliness in Sondu market thus exposing the traders and the general public to unfounded filth with eminent health risks especially the risks of cholera and related public health pandemics.
- ii. Give details of the plans the department has to provide sustainable uninterrupted flowing clean and accessible water in adequate quantities that has been lacking in Nyabondo and Sondu markets thus contributing to the growing concerns of public health related risks.
- iii. Provide details of the plan the department has to offer immediate emptying and treating of the overflowing toilets in Sondu market as well as construction of adequate public toilets and provision of lighting system in both Sondu and Nyabondo markets.
