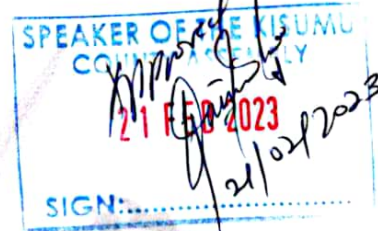

NOTICE is given that the Chairperson, Sectoral Committee on Budget and Appropriations, intends to move the following amendments to the Kisumu County Finance Bill (County Bills No. 6 of 2022) at the Committee Stage.

CODE 44

THAT code 44 be amended by;

1. Deleting in entirety;
 - a) Old town area CBD
 - b) New town area-per urban
 - c) Outside County
2. Inserting a new statement '**for a 5km radius from central sub county/ward ambulance location in all sub counties**' immediately after the words 'Minimum Charge' to read as follows;
 - i. Minimum Charge for a 5km radius from central sub county/ward ambulance location in all sub counties.
3. Deleting the digits '**2000**' against 'Minimum Charge and replacing with digits '**500**'
4. Inserting the word '**additional**' immediately after the word 'per' and a new statement '**outside the 5km radius from central sub county ambulance location**' immediately after 'KM' on the item 'Rate per KM' to read as follows;
 - ii. Rate per additional KM outside the 5km radius from central sub county ambulance location.

A. STATEMENT ON THE DEGRATING ACTIVITIES AGAINST WOMEN TRADERS IN EXCHANGE FOR FISH ALONG BEACHES IN KISUMU.

Pursuant to Standing Order 41(2,a, b), I rise to seek a Statement from the Chairpersons of the Committees on (i) Agriculture, Fisheries and Livestock Development, and (ii) Labour, Gender and Social Welfare; on the degrading activities against women traders in exchange for fish along the beaches in Kisumu County.

Hon. Speaker, there is widespread degrading activity perpetrated against women fishmongers in the beaches of Kisumu County where, women fishmongers are forcefully duped into dangerous sexual encounters in exchange for fish from the fishermen. The practice is escalated by organized cartels of fishermen and established traders who purposefully hoard fish thus making it difficult to acquire by ordinary female traders-



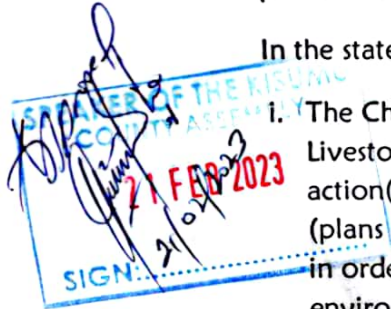

thus forcing them into sex-for-fish; a dangerous gender degrading practice commonly referred to as '*jaboya*.'

In the statement;



- i. The Chairperson of the Committee on Agriculture, Fisheries and Livestock Development should give detailed explanations of the action(s) and or plans the County Department of Fisheries has taken (plans to take) to regulate fishing and fish-trading along the beaches in order to allow a conducive and equal opportunity trading environment free from fish hoarding and sex-for-fish practices
- ii. The Chairperson of the Committee on Labour, Gender and Social Welfare should give detailed explanations of the action(s) and or plans the County Department of Gender has put in place to provide gender sensitive first-response points of call in which such gender degrading activities along the beaches, such as the practice of *jaboya*, can be immediately reported and addressed to give the women traders confidence and protection as they go about their trade.
