which allow the County Assembly to continue its legislative work while also recognizing the necessity of periodic recess periods.

FURTHER ACKNOWLEDGING the House Calendar Notice issued on 21st February 2023, where it was resolved that the *short recess would commence on Friday 27th October, 2023, and conclude on Monday 6th November, 2023*, we underscore the significance of adhering to our legislative calendar to harmonize our responsibilities, to engage more closely with our constituents, facilitate committee work, address essential administrative tasks, and to provide much-needed breaks in the legislative process.

RECOGNIZING THAT the County Assembly Standing Orders No. 26(3) provides that; *on a day when the County Assembly is scheduled to adjourn to a day other than the next normal sitting day in accordance with the County Assembly calendar, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party or another Member of the County Assembly Business Committee shall move a Motion of adjournment which shall be debated for not more than three hours after which the County Assembly shall adjourn without question put.*

NOW THEREFORE, given these considerations and the collective well-being of our legislative body, I now urge Members to adjourn the House until **Tuesday 7th November, 2023**, in accordance with Kisumu County Assembly Standing Orders No. 25(3), to enable maintenance of the balance between our legislative duties and personal lives thus ensuring robust engagement with our constituents, and allowing us to fulfill our legislative functions more effectively.
