THE KISUMU COUNTY AGRICULTURAL FACILITIES IMPROVEMENT FINANCING
BILL, 2023 (KISUMU COUNTY BILL NO. 9)

A Bill for

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Kisumu to give effect to Section 109 (2) (b) of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 to establish financial management framework for defraying the operational expenses of Kisumu county Agricultural Entities and connected purposes.

MEMORUNDAM OF OBJECT AND REASONS

The principle object of this Bill is to give effect of Section 5 (1) of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012; mandate the County Agricultural Entities to retain money received by or on behalf of the County Government for the purposes of defraying their expenses; and provide for the financial management procedures for accounting and use of money retained by the County Agricultural Entities.

Statement of how the Bill concerns the County Government of Kisumu

This Bill concerns the County Government of Kisumu in terms of Article 185, 186 and 185 and the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution and Section 5 and 109 of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012.

Statement of Delegation of Legislative Powers and Limitation of Fundamental Rights and Freedoms

This Bill does not contain any provisions limiting any fundamental rights or freedoms. The Bill however delegates legislative authority to the County Executive Committee Member responsible for Agriculture to make regulations.

Statement that the Bill is a money Bill, within the meaning of Article 114 of the Constitution.

Financial Impact Statement

The enactment of this Bill shall occasion additional expenditure of public funds.

MEMORUNDAM OF OBJECT AND REASONS

The principle object of this Bill is to establish an administrative framework for consultation, collaboration, co-operation and co-ordination with the Kisumu County Agricultural Sector and give effect to the Article 185, Article 186 and Article 187 of the Constitution of Kenya and Section 34 of the County Government Act, 2012.

Statement of how the Bill concerns the County Government of Kisumu

This Bill concerns the County Government of Kisumu in terms of Article 185, 186 and 185 and the Fourth Schedule of the Constitution.

Statement of Delegation of Legislative Powers and Limitation of Fundamental Rights and Freedoms

This Bill does not contain any provisions limiting any fundamental rights or freedoms. The Bill however delegates legislative authority to the County Executive Committee Member responsible for Agriculture to make non-financial regulations for the better implementation of the Act and the County Executive Committee Member for Finance to make regulations related to the administration and management of the Kisumu County Agricultural Fund.
